# Tufts University Chaplaincy 2019 CAFE Pre-Orientation Peer Leader

The mission of the CAFE Pre-Orientation Program is to welcome, gather, equip, and network the religious, spiritual, ethical, and interfaith leaders of the incoming class–leaders who are committed both to mutual inspiration and to making positive change in the world. The program involves:

- exploration of self and others;
- identifying strengths in religious and philosophical literacy and room to grow;
- consciousness-raising about issues of social justice on campus and in the wider community;
- and training on how to make a positive change through community organizing and activism.

Reporting to the University Chaplaincy Program Manager and the CAFE Pre-Orientation Student Coordinator, CAFE Peer Leaders will serve as the primary student leaders for incoming students during the CAFE Pre-Orientation program. We seek returning Tufts students who are passionate about multifaith engagement and social change and enthusiastic about welcoming incoming students with these interests.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

### CAFE Pre-Orientation:

- Assist with the recruitment of incoming student participants for the CAFE Pre-Orientation program, including during Jumbo Days, which are scheduled for April 2019
- Participate in Peer Leader training meeting in Spring 2019 semester
- Be back on campus for Peer Leader meeting on Monday, August 19, 2019
- Participate in two-day Peer Leader training on Tuesday, August 20 and Wednesday, August 21, 2019
- Assist with incoming student arrival day on Thursday, August 22, 2019
- Serve as the primary student leaders and contacts for incoming students during the CAFE Pre-Orientation program and assist with all aspects of the program on-site from Thursday, August 22-Tuesday, August 27, 2019
- Assist with set-up and break-down for activities and sessions throughout

the program

- Facilitate reflection activities and co-lead program sessions for incoming students
- Participate fully in all sessions and activities
- Answer questions and inquiries from incoming student participants and families

### **Basic Requirements:**

- Currently-enrolled First-year, Sophomore, or Junior planning to enroll for the Fall 2019 semester as a Tufts University student
- Must remain in good academic and behavioral standing with the University
- Presence on campus from Monday, August 19-Tuesday, August 27, 2019
- Respond to emails and other communications sent out by University Chaplaincy staff in a timely manner
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Enthusiasm for working with incoming students and welcoming new students to Tufts
- Ability to work in a religiously and philosophically-diverse setting
- Desire to engage in conversations around different religious and philosophical viewpoints
- Professionalism, empathy, and ability to manage confidential information
- Self-motivation, ability to prioritize, ability to function in a fast-paced environment, attention to detail, thoroughness, and follow-through
- Prior experience in student leadership positions, and especially interfaith or social justice leadership positions, recommended
